Access To Health

If you are a carer it can be difficult to respond to an urgent problem, such as your own health failing. When someone depends on you it is difficult to just drop everything to see to your own needs. The aim of this service 'Access to Health' is:

- ✦ To organise, through staff and volunteers, support for the cared for—giving you peace of mind whilst you attend appointments/receive treatment
- ✦ To assist you attend either for day hospital or inpatient treatment by liaising with appropriate agencies
- ✦ To accompany you and the person you care for to health appointments

- ✦ To provide a 'Sitting Service' whilst you attend a medical appointment
- ✦ To offer Signposting to other appropriate agencies
- ✦ To negotiate with Health Professionals to enable appointments and treatments to be arranged at times and venues that can fit in with your commitments
